



Which applies to federal, state, and local governments– including public schools. This is settled constitutional law, not a matter of political preference. In fact, the Supreme Court has repeatedly ruled that the government may not prefer one religion

ILLEGAL POSTER

Required by a Texas law S.B.No.A10.

...over another or prefer religion over non-religion.

"The pre-eminent purpose for posting the Ten Commandments on schoolroom walls is plainly religious." — Stone v. Graham (1980)

By requiring schools to display the King James Version of the Ten Commandments, the state is supporting a specific religious belief. Calling them part of history does not change the fact they are religious scripture.

And because students must attend school by law, they cannot avoid these messages. So even "voluntary" religion in school isn't really voluntary when required by the government.

DIY GUIDE

Print the Poster

- Print this file at 100% scale. Use single-sided printing only.
- Do NOT resize or "fit to page."

Trim the Pages

- Cut off the white borders from each page.
- Do not cut off the areas labeled "Glue." These areas are required for assembly. Some printers may partially trim the edges of the glue areas, so use the image on the right as a reference when trimming.
- Carefully align the pages by matching edges and artwork.

Assemble the Poster

- Apply glue or double-sided tape to each area marked "Glue" and attach the two halves together

Hang the poster

- Once fully dry place companion poster under your display.
