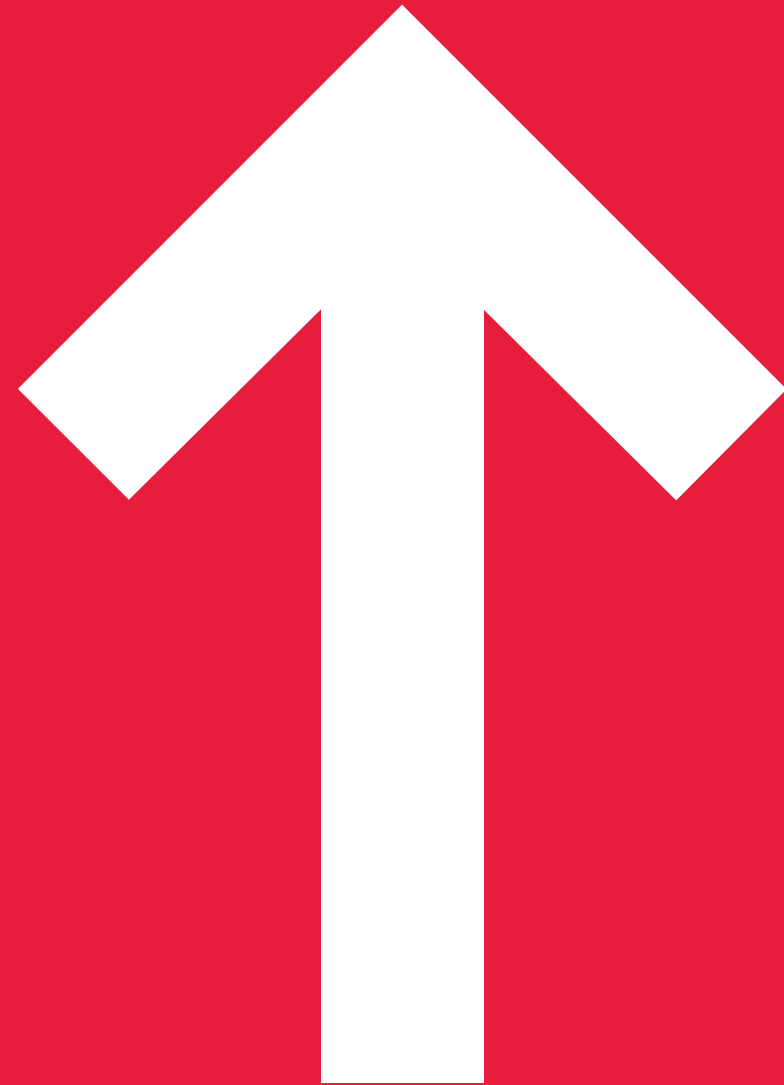

This display is required by Texas law (SB 10),
but the law violates your First Amendment rights.

Texas SB 10 violates the U.S. Constitution.

"Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion..."

Which applies to federal, state, and local governments- including public schools. This is settled constitutional law, not a matter of political preference. In fact, the Supreme Court has repeatedly ruled that the government may not prefer one religion

over another or prefer religion over non-religion.

"The pre-eminent purpose for posting the Ten Commandments on schoolroom walls is plainly religious." — Stone v. Graham (1980)

By requiring schools to display the King James Version of the Ten Commandments, the state is supporting a specific religious belief. Calling them part of history does not change the fact they are religious scripture.

And because students must attend school by law, they cannot avoid these messages. So even "voluntary" religion in school isn't really voluntary when required by the government.

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
